
MIXING COLOR EXPLANATION



White: Is manly used to create highlights. It is very transparent and diluited type of white.

Covered White: very covering white, to be used in very limited quantities, with particular attention.

Yellow: Add a couple of drops of yellow into the capsule of your main color to make it lighter. It is a transparent color made of iron oxide.

Orange: Add a couple of drops of orange into the capsule of your main color to make it warmer. It is a transparent color so feel free to add more drops till you reach the desired shade.

Mineral Red: Add half a drop of Mineral Red into the capsule of your main color to make it redder. It is a very concentrated pigment so be careful because if you add more than half drop the color might turn too red. It is a brick red made of iron oxide.

Bright Red: It is a pure organic red, should only be used on lips. Add few drops of Bright Red into the capsule to make your main lip color brighter.

Green: Add half a drop of Green into the capsule of your main color to make it more green. It should only be used to camouflage red eyebrows.

It is a very concentrated pigment so be careful because if you add more than half drop the color might turn too green. Do never use alone. It is made of chrome dioxide.

Black: Add few drops into the darkest eyebrow color if you work on a very dark skin (african-american). It can also be used pure to perform a short term eyeliner.

Cold Grey: It is mainly used to perform the shading part of shading eyeliners.
